Project Background

The St. Tammany Parish Government, in collaboration with local stakeholders and community input, is developing the Comprehensive Pedestrian & Bicycle Plan to enhance the community's pedestrian and cycling infrastructure. This initiative aims to identify gaps in the transportation network and assess land use, recreational facilities, and barriers to access. Through workshops, surveys, and pop-up events, we will gather community feedback on preferred routes and improvements, ensuring that the final recommendations reflect the needs of our residents.

The master plan will propose an interconnected network of on- and off-street facilities, complete with cost estimates for each project. We will prioritize initiatives based on community impact while also identifying potential funding sources for implementation.

By integrating community insights and adhering to federal requirements, the St. Tammany Parish Comprehensive Pedestrian & Bicycle Plan aims to create a sustainable, connected, and accessible transportation system for current and future residents.

Project Timeline

The project kicked off in July 2024 and is estimated to wrap up by December 2025. Follow the calendar on the project website to stay informed about upcoming events.

How to Get Involved

Public input will directly guide the project's recommendations and prioritized improvements of pedestrian and bicycle facilities in St. Tammany Parish! There are many ways for you to get involved in the planning process.

The public can get involved in the project through a variety of engagement opportunities, such as public workshops, pop-up events, and surveys. These events are designed to be inclusive, with locations chosen based on accessibility and to ensure participation from disadvantaged and underrepresented communities. Additionally, materials will be available in Spanish to overcome language barriers, and all feedback gathered in person or online will be tracked to ensure that community input directly shapes the development of the Master Plan, including pedestrian and bicycle network improvements and prioritization of future projects.

Workshops & Pop Up Events

Events will be held throughout the parish. Dates and locations are posted on the project website. Reminders for the events will be on the Parish's social media.

The first round of engagement will happen in January & February 2025.

The second round of engagement will happen in June & July 2025.

Online Survey

The survey will be available in multiple languages on the project website for residents of the parish. Dates and locations are posted on the project website.

The first survey will be open to the public from January 9 to February 6, 2025.

The second survey will be open to the public from June 13 to July 11, 2025.
